- 201 Trinity Hill Pinot Noir 2006, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand 25.00  
Black fruits such as cherries and plums on the nose, then the palate. Earthy, smoky notes help give structure to this medium bodied wine with great length. If you drink Pinot Noir, you will love this. 5.95/8.50
- 202 Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2002, Les Climats, Louis Jadot, Burgundy France. 43.00  
Wow, do not share with friends. Everything a good Burgundy Pinot Noir should be.
- 203 Domaine Carneros Avant Garde Pinot Noir 2004, Carneros, California. 35.00  
Taittinger opened a vineyard on a hillside in Carneros identical to their chateau in Reims. They are making fantastic wine and their Pinot Noirs are out of this world. This example is earthy and brimming over with violets, raspberry and velvety tannins.
- 204 Pinot Noir Yering Station 2004, Yarra Valley, Victoria Australia 30.00  
A rich, silky and elegant wine with aromas of black cherry and plum, complex floral undertones with hints of spice. On the palate red berries and toasty oak are dominant a savoury spice finish. This wine will make you smile and smile and smile!

This cabernet sauvignon is a classic varietal which makes up the heart and soul of Peter Lehmann's Barossa Valley easy drinking style wine. Great quality and flavour. 5.10/6.90

 Complex aromas of blueberry, raspberry, violet and dried cranberries with a bouquet of vanilla, caramel and toasted oak. Ripe and ample tannins and lovely
